Welcome to our 100 CLUB – a great way for you to support our school!

Here's how it works...

You complete and sign the attached Member's Form and Standing Order Mandate for £5 a month (or £60 annually) or pay by cheque by the 25th of the month.

This buys you one membership number (which we will allocate), which enters you into the monthly draw. All participants must be over 16.

The draw will take place from the 1st lotto draw the following month.

If you win, a cheque will be posted to your home address and the number will be published in the school's newsletter and on the school's website.

The prize money will be 50% of the membership fee taken that month. The remaining 50% goes to the school PTFA to help fund our initiatives (e.g. equipment, resources and opportunities for students).

100 CLUB RULES

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PTFA bank account and used to meet funding requests for the school.

1. For a cost of £5 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 59.
2. The Saturday and Wednesday lotto draw bonus ball number will be used to determine the winning number.
3. As the bonus ball number only goes up to 59, when there are 60 members the group will be split into 2 groups of 30, each having their own draw. Members will be advised which group they are part of and new members will be allocated to each group accordingly.
4. Each month there will be a 1st prize for that months draw for 50% of the fee taken for that month for each group running.
5. The prizes will total 50% of the annual income.
6. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Frewen College. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
7. Numbers are not limited and members can have more than one entry.
8. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or annual cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
9. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
10. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
11. The draw will be from the 1st lotto bonus ball number (either Saturday or Wednesday) that runs from the 1st of the following month after payment.
12. If there are no winning numbers from the first lotto draw bonus ball number then the draw will be taken from the next lotto draw bonus ball number (either Wednesday or Saturday). This will continue for all draws for the month until a winning number is drawn or we reach the end of that month.
13. If no winner is drawn for the month then the money will pass to the Frewen College PFTA account. The Frewen College PTFA will confirm if and when any extra bonus draw will be made against these funds.
14. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
15. The winning name and number for each month will be posted in the school newsletter and/or on the school website.
16. The 100 Club will be run by the PTFA. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
17. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
18. If a winner cannot be contacted or funds unclaimed, the winnings will be placed into PTFA funds after six months.
